

Requirements for Continuing into Commerce Level 2

30 Units Required for Business 1

Once you have attempted a minimum of 24 units in Business I, your course work will be evaluated. The Reviewing Committee will use the following criteria to determine if admission into Commerce II has been achieved.

Required courses must be successfully completed on your first attempt only. You cannot fail any required courses and you will not be permitted to re-take any courses. The required courses include:

Commerce 1E03

Commerce 1PA0

Computer Science 1BA3

Economics 1B03

Economics 1BB3

Math 1M03 OR **Math 1A03** OR **Math 1LS3**

Math 1F03 - only those students who did not complete Grade 12 Calculus and Vectors U are required to register into this course

Stats 1L03 - only those students who did not complete Grade 12 Mathematics of Data Management U or equivalent are required to complete this course

And one of - **Anthropology 1A03, Geography 1HA3, Geography 1HB3, Psychology 1X03 and Sociology 1A06, Health Age 1AA3, Health Age 1BB3, Political Science 1G06, Religious Studies 1B06**

- If you have successfully completed a **minimum** of 24 units of Business 1 coursework, you must have completed all **REQUIRED** courses of the Business I Program, in order to be eligible for entry into Commerce 2.
- You must achieve a Cumulative Average (CA) of at least **5.0** (63%) on your **first 24 to 30 units** attempted.
- You are permitted to fail a maximum of 6 units of **electives** in Business I. However, you will still need to achieve a CA of at least 5.0 (63%) that will include the units of failed electives.

REMEMBER:

The rules regarding continuing into Commerce Level 2 are as follows:

- Must have successfully completed a minimum of 24 units
- Must be successful on first attempt only
- Must have completed and passed all required course work
- Permitted to fail up to 6 units of elective course work. Must achieve a minimum cumulative average of least 5.0 (63%), which would include failed electives.
- Not permitted to repeat a course or to continue on probation, for consideration in your evaluation

The minimum cumulative average of 5.0 is strictly upheld. Students whose average is slightly below 5.0 do not have the option of continuing on academic probation to remain in the Commerce Program.
